ANSWER: The property owner


While the City is responsible for the main ditch that supplies water TO properties and laterals, it is the individual property owner's responsibility to clean and maintain the laterals.


We also want to thank **Elite Extrication & Equipment** for coming to Riggins and teaching this class. Top notch instructors.
