CITY OF RIGGINS ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIGGINS, IDAHO COUNTY, IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SECTIONS 7 CHAPTER 2 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE, NOW CITY OF RIGGINS, BY AMENDING SECTION 7-2-3(B) SUCH THAT THE APPROVAL OF REQUESTS FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAYS BE CONSIDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE FIRE CHIEF; PROVIDING FURTHER THAT THE CITY BE AN ADDITIONAL INSURED ON PYROTECHNIC VENDOR'S INSURANCE POLICY; PROVIDING FURTHER REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT WITHIN THE RIGGINS CITY LIMITS; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE ORDINANCE BECOMING EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL, AND PUBLICATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIGGINS, IDAHO COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

SECTION 1 - Amendment of Section 7-2-3(B) of the Municipal Code of the Village, now City, of Riggins. Section 7-2-3(B) of the Municipal Code of the Village, now City of Riggins, shall be amended to read as follows:

7-2-3(B): <u>Exceptions</u>: The Riggins City Council, in conjunction with the City of Riggins Fire Chief, may consider and approve all requests for pyrotechnic displays, and may require the vendor providing the fireworks display to list the City of Riggins as an additional insured in the amount of \$2,000,000 on their insurance policy, and to provide the City of Riggins with a copy of such insurance certificate.

SECTION 3 – All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4 – Provides for passage, publication, either in entirety or by summary, in compliance with Section 50-901A Idaho Code, and an effective date.

PASSED: This ordinance passed under a suspension of the rule requiring three readings on separate days at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the $/3^{th}$ day of June, 2016.
