CITY OF RIGGINS ORDINANCE NO. 217

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIGGINS, IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF RIGGINS MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 1-8-4, SETTING TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE RIGGINS CITY COUNCIL, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIGGINS, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 1-8-4 of the Riggins Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

1-8-4 TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING: The Council shall hold meetings regularly on the second Wednesday of each month. Such meeting shall be held in the City Council Chambers and shall commence at six thirty (6:30) p.m. The Mayor, or one half (1/2) plus one of the membership of the Council may call Special Meetings, the object of which must be submitted to the members and the call, object and the disposition hereof shall be entered upon the journal by the Clerk. If the regular meeting day of any month is a holiday, or if a quorum of the City Council cannot be present, the meeting may be rescheduled, provided that public notice of the meeting change is provided, as according to Idaho Code.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and that the remainder of said ordinances shall remain in full force and effect and is hereby ratified in all respects.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect with the first regular meeting in January 2016, upon its passage, approval and publication in the Idaho County Free Press.
